1. Outline of Support

We will provide financial support for those who have outstanding research proposal matched the purpose of HIGO Program.

2. Qualification for Applicants

Applicants should be HIGO Program regular course students (Except for associate course students).

This support is for those who don't receive the similar financial support from others.

3. Details of financial support and the period

(1) What financial support is used for

The grant should be used for research expenses for consumables and the grant is up to 1,000,000yen per project.

Not intended for travel expenses.

(2) Period of financial support

Those who receive the support have to use up the grant by the end of January in 2014.

4. Limitation of Number of Applications

Each applicant can apply for one project.

5. Number of acceptances

Up to 5 projects will be selected.

6. Selection Process

(1) Screening of application forms (first screening)

HIGO Program committee members evaluate the research plans etc. based on the application forms.

(2) Screening of presentations (second screening)

Those who pass the screening of the application forms will make presentations. The selection committee members choose the expected number of applicants based on the result of the presentations.

7. How to Apply

Applicants should obtain the approval of the supervisor (written in Section 8) prior to

submitting the application.

One original and 13 copies (14 documents) completed in English (each printed on both sides of one A4 sheet) should be submitted to the below contact address (Submitting by E-mail is not acceptable):

8. Project Supervisor

For a given project, a supervisor (a full-time professor, associate professor or lecturer of Kumamoto University who is a qualified instructor at graduate school.) shall supervise the research and will undertake responsibility of the accomplishment of the project.

9. Deadline

The application should be submitted by no later than 4pm on September 27th (Friday), 2013.

10. Obligations

Those who receive research funds under this project should submit a comprehensive report on the research (report form will be notified) to the Advanced Research/Education Promotion Division by no later than February 28 (Friday), 2014
